The Food Bank of the Southern Tier will be happy to accept venison donations from the village of Cayuga Heights. Because donated deer must be professionally processed, the Venison Donation Coalition coordinates a program where legally tagged and properly field dressed deer can be taken to participating processors at no cost. The approved processor in Tompkins County is Broken Antler Deer Processing, phone 607 273-0389. You must call ahead for free processing of any deer you wish to donate.

One deer provides approximately 160 servings of highly nutritious ground venison to those in need. Venison is higher in protein and leaner than ground beef. The Food Bank of the Southern Tier greatly appreciates your help in the fight against hunger.
