Dear Mr. Therrien:

I am writing to request the renewal of the Village of Cayuga Heights LCP #1708.

The Village intends to continue our program of deer management and as such intends to capture and surgically sterilize any remaining unsterilized does as well as any new immigrants. Our intention is to maintain a sterilization rate of at least 95%. Based upon the enclosed reports from White Buffalo, Inc. and Cornell University, we estimate needing to capture and sterilize approximately 20 -30 does. We also request permission for the inadvertent capture of bucks during the immobilization process.


- Our renewal application and Designated Agent form
- Copies of reports from White Buffalo, Inc. and Cornell University regarding our sterilization work in December 2012 and the subsequent population analysis in January 2013
- Check for \$10 License renewal fee

Village officials understand that using fertility control alone is a long-term effort, and deer sterilization alone may not achieve our management objectives for a reduced herd size. We are currently evaluating whether we have sites to implement a parallel limited culling program, as authorized by the Modified Consent Order issued by the DEC to the Village (DEC Case No R&-2006011-2). Regardless of whether we have culling sites, we intend to continue the surgical sterilization program begun in December 2012.

The Village is currently negotiating contracts with White Buffalo, Inc. for the capture and sterilization of female deer, and with Cornell University for a population estimate. The Village currently plans to initiate these efforts on or about December 1, 2013.

I AM REQUESTING THAT THE FOLLOWING CHANGES BE MADE TO MY NEW LICENSE. (Please attach additional sheets if necessary.)

License Condition #1 - Revise license to authorize capture, possess, transport and release up to thirty (30) female white-tailed deer for the purpose of surgical sterilization.

License Condition #5 - Revise license to capture and temporarily possess up to ten (10) male white-tailed deer for purposes of tagging.

The Village of Cayuga Heights will consider adding limited culling should sufficient culling sites be available (as allowed by Modified Consent Order (DEC Case No. RS=2006011-2)

Step 2. Attach copies of your Annual Report or other documents as required by the license conditions on your current license. Please read your license conditions and attach copies of any reports or other documents that are required.

Step 3. Attach a check or money order for your license fee (if required) payable to: New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (Please Do Not Send Cash).

Step 4. Sign and date the Notice at the bottom of this form.

Step 5. In order for the Special Licenses Unit to process your renewal request, you must send: 1) a complete signed and dated copy of this "Notice of License Renewal" form, 2) a copy of your Annual Report form or other documents as required by the license conditions on your current license, and 3) a check or money order for your license fee (if required).
