Dear Ms. Mills:

Under the provisions of the New York Freedom of Information Law, Article 6 of the Public Officers Law, I hereby request the necessary documents which legally prove the citizenship of Trustee Diana Riesman. According to Robert Freeman, not only is this request legal and appropriate for a FOIL request, but as Clerk, you have a duty to determine that any elected official is serving legally when the question arises. As you know, this is my second request to determine if Diana Riesman is in fact a legal US citizen. Mr. Freeman informed me that my first request was legal and that Village Attorney Randy Marcus's denial was illegal. He encouraged me to appeal and sue if necessary, which I intend to do. Given the length of time since the first request, I am asking again for the information - which is of course not available at the Village Hall and does not need to be. She is to provide it to you so that you can do your job per Mr. Freeman. A birth certificate and passport or citizenship papers are required.

If there are any fees for copying the records requested, please inform me before filling the request.

As you know, the Freedom of Information Law requires that an agency respond to a request within five business days of receipt of a request. Therefore, I would appreciate a response as soon as possible and look forward to hearing from you shortly. If for any reason any portion of my request is denied, please inform me of the reasons for the denial in writing and provide the name and address of the person or body to whom an appeal should be directed.
