

**Village of Cayuga Heights
Local Law No. 3 of the Year 2009**

A local law amending Village of Cayuga Heights Local Law #2 of 2009 to modify the effective date of said Local Law concerning the Appointment of members to the Planning Board Independent of the members of the Board of Trustees.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cayuga Heights as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND INTENT.

The purpose of this Local Law is to amend Local Law No. 2 of 2009, entitled "A Local Law Amending Village of Cayuga Heights Local Law No. 2 of 1992: Establishment of Planning Board, To Provide for the Appointment of Members of the Planning Board Independent of the Board of Trustees," to provide for a postponement of the effective date of said Local Law until all new, independent members of the Planning Board have been identified and appointed. The intent of this Local Law is to provide the Village's Mayor and Board of Trustees of the Village's Planning Board, to select among such individuals and to make appointments to the Planning Board, and in the interim allow the Village's Planning Board to continue to function as it did prior to the enactment of Local Law No. 2 with the members of the Village's Board of Trustees serving as the members of the Planning Board.

SECTION II. AUTHORITY.

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the grant of powers to local governments provided for in (i) Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law to adopt and amend local laws not inconsistent with the provisions of the New York State Constitution or not inconsistent with any general law relating to its property, affairs, government or other subjects provided for in said Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, (ii) Section 10 of the Statute of Local Governments, (iii) Article 5-J of the General Municipal Law and (iv) Section 7-718 of the Village Law.

SECTION III. AMENDMENT OF LOCAL LAW NO. 2

The effective date set forth in Section VI of Local Law No. 2 of 2009, which was stated to be the date of filing with the New York Secretary of State, is hereby amended as follows. Local Law No. 3 of the year 2009 shall be effective as of the effective date of the appointment of all four members of the Planning Board and, in addition, a chairperson of the Planning Board, and in addition an alternate member of the Planning Board, in accordance with the terms and provisions of Local Law No. 2 of 2009.

SECTION IV. SUPERCEDING EFFECT.

All Local Laws, resolutions, rules, regulations and other enactments of the Village of Cayuga Heights in conflict with the provisions of this Local Law are hereby superceded to the extent necessary to give this Local Law full force and effect.

SECTION V. VALIDITY.

The invalidity of any provision of this Local Law shall not affect the validity of any other provision of this Local Law that can be given effect without such invalid provision.

SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Local Law shall be effective as of the date of filing with the New York Secretary of State.
