

**Village of Cayuga Heights
Local Law No. 5 of the year 2010**

A local law amending section 6, "Speed Regulations" of the Village of Cayuga Heights traffic control law, local law number 3 of the year 1991.

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Cayuga Heights as follows:

SECTION 1. PURPOSE AND INTENT.

The purpose of this Local Law is to amend Section 6, "Speed Regulations", of the Village of Cayuga Heights Traffic Control Law, Local Law Number 3 of the Year 1991, in order to reduce the maximum speed limit in the vicinity of a school from twenty (20) miles per hour to fifteen (15) miles per hour. The intent of this Local Law is to provide that the speed limit on the portions of the Village streets adjacent to the Cayuga Heights Elementary School, those being portions of Hanshaw Road, East Upland Road and The Parkway, are set at a maximum of fifteen (15) miles per hour.

SECTION II. AUTHORITY.

This Local Law is enacted pursuant to the grant of powers to local governments provided for in (i) Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law to adopt and amend local laws not inconsistent with the provisions of the New York State Constitution or not inconsistent with any general law relating to its property, affairs, government or other subjects provided for in said Section 10 of the Municipal Home Rule Law, (ii) Section 10 of the Statute of Local Governments and (iii) Article 5-J of the General Municipal Law.

SECTION III. AMENDMENT OF SECTION 6 OF THE VILLAGE OF CAYUGA HEIGHTS TRAFFIC CONTROL LAW, LOCAL LAW NUMBER 3 OF THE YEAR 1991.

As of the effective date of this Local Law, the following text will replace the entirety of Section 6 of the Village's Traffic Control Law, Local Law Number 3 of the Year 1991:

Section 6: Speed Regulations

Maximum Speed Limits. Thirty (30) miles per hour is hereby established as the maximum speed limit at which vehicles may proceed on highways within the corporate limits of the Village of Cayuga Heights, except (1) NYS Route 13 and (2) the maximum speed limit in the vicinity of a school is hereby established to be fifteen (15) miles per hour for a distance not to exceed 1,320 feet along all Village streets and highways

adjacent to a school, during school days between the hours of 7 o'clock a.m. and 6 o'clock p.m.

SECTION IV. SUPERCEDING EFFECT.

All Local Laws, resolutions, rules, regulations and other enactments of the Village of Cayuga Heights in conflict with the provisions of this Local Law are hereby superceded to the extent necessary to give this Local Law full force and effect.

SECTION V. VALIDITY.

The invalidity of any provision of this Local Law shall not affect the validity of any other provision of this Local Law that can be given effect without such invalid provision.

SECTION VI. EFFECTIVE DATE.

This Local Law shall be effective as of the date of filing with the New York Secretary of State.
