We'll gather at the intersection of White Park Road and the Parkway and then stroll along a few of the roads in the area where interesting houses have stories to tell about their architecture and the people who lived in them a century ago. Parking will be available, for those who need it, in the lot of the First Congregational Church, 309 Highland Road.
