

## CENSUS WORKERS ARE IN THIS AREA

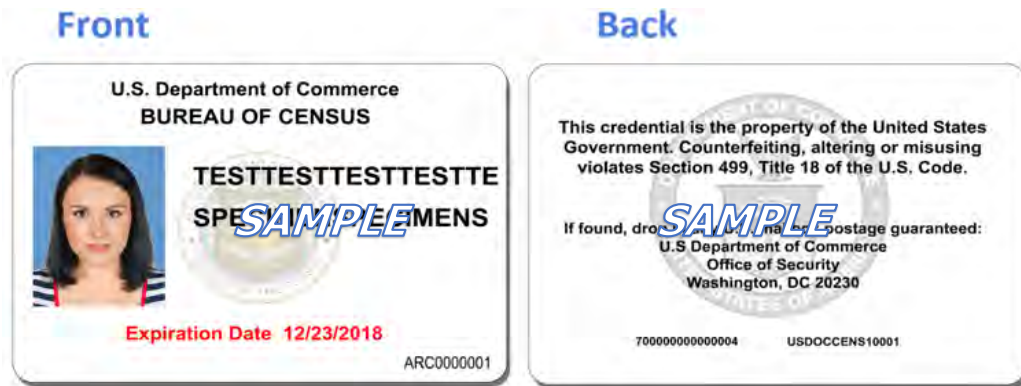
### YOU MAY GET CALLS

The U.S. Census Bureau conducts field operations nationwide on an ongoing basis. During the 2020 Census there will be a significant increase in the field operation activity. Your department or agency may get questions from local residents about strangers in their neighborhoods. The Census Bureau wants to make sure that local law enforcement can identify census bureau employees, both temporary decennial employees and permanent field representatives.

### HOW TO VERIFY EMPLOYMENT

Each temporary decennial Census employee will have an official identification card with the employees name, picture, and an expiration date. Regional level staff can be identified by their Personal Identity Verification (PIV) Card. Regional level staff can be identified by their PIV Card. Temporary decennial employees can be identified by their Census Identification Card, as well as either their Census iPhone with a Census Bureau logo on the back, or a laptop with the Census logo and a canvass bag with the Census logo.

*SHOULD THE PUBLIC BE CONCERNED WITH HOW CENSUS DATA IS PROTECTED?*

Federal law protects your privacy and keeps your answers confidential (Title 13, United States Code, Sections 9 and 214). The answers you give on the census form cannot be obtained by law enforcement or tax collection agencies. Your answers cannot be used in court. They cannot be obtained with a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request. As allowed by law, census data becomes public after 72 years (Title 44, United States Code, Section 2108).
