

Where you get the accessible parking hangtag depends on where you live while here. See below. (If you so choose, you can instead get this from your home state/city/town in the United States as well. All accessible parking hangtags or license plates issued in the US are honored in other states.)

To get a New York state accessible parking hangtag, you and your health care provider would need to complete this form: <https://dmv.ny.gov/forms/mv6641.pdf>. Do NOT return to the completed form to the DMV. It needs to be returned to the appropriate office depending on the municipality (see below).
