

Walking Safe: Cayuga Heights

Existing Conditions



Kline Road is narrow, thickly vegetated and largely without even a shoulder for pedestrians to seek refuge on when traffic is passing.



Wyckoff Road is narrow, winding and thickly vegetated, posing a hazard for pedestrians.

Kline and Wyckoff Roads both lack clear crossings, resulting in many potential conflicts between pedestrians and vehicles.



The Village has worked in partnership with the Town of Ithaca and the School District to separately fund safer pedestrian facilities to be constructed along and across Lake Shore Road.



The existing Lake View Cemetery path provides a safe and direct route to schools and other destinations, but the path is in need of resurfacing and lighting.



Kline and Wyckoff Roads provide a direct link to destinations west of the village and therefore draw both pedestrian and vehicular traffic.
